NOTICE OF FEE CHANGES

Effective October 25, 2010

As a result of the enactment of Senate Bill 857 (Stats. 2010), various civil filing fees and criminal fees have been established or increased as of October 25, 2010. All new fee changes will be imposed commencing October 25, 2010 in the Plumas Superior Court. All new and increased fees sunset on July 1, 2013, except as noted below. The additional revenue from these fee changes will be used to offset reductions to trial court funding.

New fee

- \$500 renewal fee for application to appear as counsel pro hac vice for each year a case continues.
- \$10 increase to the security fee (for a total fee of \$40) (*sunset on July 1, 2011*).

Increased Fees

- \$40 increase to first paper filing fees for unlimited and limited civil cases where the amount in controversy is more than \$10,000 (for unlimited civil above \$25,000 - from \$355 to \$395); (for limited civil \$10,000 to \$25,000 - from \$330 to \$370).
- \$20 increase to first paper filing fees for limited civil cases where the amount in controversy is \$10,000 or less (from \$205 to \$225).
- \$300 increase to the summary judgment motion fee (from \$200 to \$500).
- \$250 increase to the pro hac vice fee (from \$250 to \$500).
- \$40 increase for all probate fees authorized by GC 70650, GC 70651, GC 70652, GC70653, GC 70655, GC 70658 (from \$355 to \$395)
- \$20 increase for probate and family law filing fees authorized by GC 79654, GC 70656 and H&S Code 103470 (from \$205 to \$225)
