

## **Tentative Rulings**

#### **Probate – 9:00 a.m.**

##### **Case No. PR17-00024 – Conservatorship of Magnuson**

Tentative Ruling: **Granted.** The court finds that notice has been given as required by law. Petitioner's Petition for Instructions and Authorizing Filing of Petition for Successor Trustee is granted.

##### **Case No. PR18-00005 – Estate of Hanson**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court notes there is no inventory and appraisal attached to the petition, as required by Probate Code section 13152(b).

##### **Case No. PR18-00003 – Estate of Frazier**

Tentative Ruling: **Granted.** The court finds that notice has been given as required by law. Petitioner's Petition to Administer Estate is granted.

##### **Case No. PR18-00004 – Estate of Haas**

Tentative Ruling: **Granted.** The court finds that notice has been given as required by law. Petitioner's Petition to Determine Succession to Real Property is granted. Petitioner is to prepare the order.

##### **Case No. PR18-00006 – Estate of Hobart**

Tentative Ruling: **Granted.** The court finds that notice has been given as required by law. Petitioner's Petition to Determine Succession to Real Property is granted. Petitioner is to prepare the order.

**Case No. PR17-00013 – Estate of McKay**

Tentative Ruling: **Granted.** The court finds that notice has been given as required by law. Petitioner's Petition for Distribution is granted. Petitioner is to prepare the order.

**Case No. PR17-00060 – Estate of Walter**

Tentative Ruling: **Approved, upon filing of an amended proof of service.** The court notes that the date of mailing on notice is not filled in. If an amended notice is filed prior to the hearing, the court will find that notice has been given as required by law, and grant the Petition for Probate. Petitioner is to prepare the order.

**Case No. PR18-00001 – Estate of White**

Tentative Ruling: **Granted.** The court finds that notice has been given as required by law. Petitioner Petition for Probate is granted.

**Case No. PR17-000052 – Guardianship of Donohue**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court notes there is no investigator's report in the file.

**Case No. PR16-00059 – Guardianship of Neely**

Tentative Ruling: **No appearance required.** The court has received and reviewed the confidential guardianship status report. The court finds it is in the minor's best interests to continue the guardianship. The court will set the annual review hearing for February 13, 2019, at 9:00a.m. The clerk of the court is reminded to send notice to the guardian one month prior to this date, informing the guardian of the duty to file a confidential status report prior to the review hearing.

**Civil – 9:30 a.m.**

**Case No. CV17-00207 – Petition of Shelters**

Tentative Ruling: **Granted.** The court finds that notice has been given as required by law. Petitioner's petition is granted.

**Case No. CV17-00023 – Redwood Credit Union vs. Hinds**

Tentative Ruling: **No appearance required.** The court notes that the summary judgment motion was mistakenly calendared for a hearing on February 14, which did not allow the statutory 75 day time period for notice. However the court notes that there is a settlement conference scheduled for February 15, at 1:30, which will be confirmed. The hearing on the summary judgment motion will be rescheduled at the conference for a later date, if the case is not settled.

**Case No. FL16-00178 – Mar. of Castillo**

Tentative Ruling: **Granted.** The court finds that notice has been given as required by law, and the respondent had filed a response consenting to the requested order. Petitioner is to prepare the Order.

**Case No. FL17-00083 – Mar. of Cokor**

Tentative Ruling: **No appearance required.** It appears to the court that respondent' request for order does not contain any new allegations or change of circumstances to warrant a hearing.

**Case No. FL17-00064 – Colwell-Meisenheimer vs. Meisenheimer**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will order the parties to mediation.

### **Case No. CV17-00086 – Azevedo vs. A-1 Glass, et al.**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will discuss the status of the case with plaintiff's counsel.

### **Case No. LC17-00021 – Bank of America vs. Hubbs**

Tentative Ruling: **No appearance required.** The court notes there is a judgment in the file.

### **Case No. FS09-00084 – County of Plumas vs. Hopkins**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will review the custody and visitation orders with the parties.

### **Case No. FL17-00166 – Ewing vs. Johnson**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will reset the trial.

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required, except that respondent may appear by telephone.** The court will review the status of the case with the parties.

### **Case No. CV17-00029 – Greening vs. Prentke**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will discuss the status of the case with the parties, and set a mandatory settlement conference.

### **Case No. CV16-00095 – Hudson vs. Hudson**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will discuss the status of the case with the parties.

### **Case No. CV16-00014 – J&S Custom Homes vs. Nakoma Associates**

Tentative Ruling: **Appearance required.** The court will confirm if a settlement conference is still requested and agree upon.
